The programme offers a flexible, multidisciplinary, skill-oriented, and student-centred system of higher education. It combines academic learning, practical exposure, value-based education, and research orientation to prepare students for higher studies, employment, entrepreneurship, and responsible citizenship

ADMISSION PROCESS

Information about admission to four year undergraduate degree courses may be seen from the college website: www.polestarcollege.ac.in. Application form and College Prospectus will be available from the College Administrative Block during office hours on cash/online payment of Rs. 200/- only. Applicants with Disabilities or those registered as Internally Displaced Person (IDPs) are admitted free of charge and exempted from examination fees. Candidates who have passed Class XII examination conducted by COHSEM or equivalent examination are eligible to apply for the course. Please note that all admissions are provisional until confirmed by the College.

While seeking admission to undergraduate courses, preference will be given to students who have passed their XII Arts or Science examination from this college. However, such students cannot claim admission to the undergraduate courses by right. Attendance by the student for regular lectures is compulsory. Appearance at the Internal Examination is compulsory.

Documents to be Submitted Along with the Application Form:

1. Two photo copies of the Mark Sheet and Certificate of Class XII or equivalent examination.
2. Two photo copies of the Admit Card of Class XII or equivalent examination.
3. Two photo copies of the Mark Sheet and Certificate of HSLC examination.
4. A photo copy of Character Certificate from the head of the institute last attended.
5. Three recent passport size photograph (not later than six month).
6. Two photo copies of the SC/ST/OBC/Minorities certificate issued by concerned authority, if applicable.
7. A copy of the Person with Disabilities certificate issued by competent authority, if applicable.
8. A copy of the Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) certificate/letter issued by competent authority, if applicable.
9. A copy of Aadhaar Card
10. Migration Certificate for applicant who passed the qualifying examination other than Council of Higher Secondary Education Manipur. The certificate must be submitted to the college within 45 days from the date of admission otherwise their admission will be invalid.
11. Original Registration Certificate / Card of Council of Higher Secondary Education Manipur (COHSEM).
12. Study break Affidavit (if applicable).
13. A copy of online payment receipt.
14. The Original Certificates are to be brought for verification at the time of admission.

Mode of Selection

Selection will be made purely on the basis of marks obtained in the Class XII examination.

Mode of Payment of Admission Fees:

Admission fees are to be paid through online payment during the stipulated time for admission and a copy of payment receipt must be deposited at the Office.

Examination Cell

The Examination Cell ensures the smooth and systematic conduct of all examinations in the institution. It maintains confidentiality, fairness, and transparency in the evaluation process.
